How you finance your degree is a big part of your decision-making process. All admitted applicants are automatically considered for merit-based program-funded assistantships; however, funding is not guaranteed. We recommend that you plan with the full program cost in mind. In addition to these start-up expenses, potential expenses to consider are moving expenses, rent deposit and monthly rent payments, books/laptop, utilities (electricity, gas, and water), etc.

**Typical Graduate Assistantships cover tuition and university fees.** Students must cover the balance. The Financial Aid Office will only process FAFSA funding for United States Citizens. Additionally, university-wide merit-based scholarships may be obtained through the Graduate School.

<sup>2</sup>Prep Course costs do not qualify for federal financial aid.

<sup>3</sup>**Winter Mini-Term Global Business Seminar**- tuition and fees listed do not cover international travel costs and incidentals (projected cost around \$2,000). Program fee for Mini-Term is a programs abroad fee.
